Planning Process:

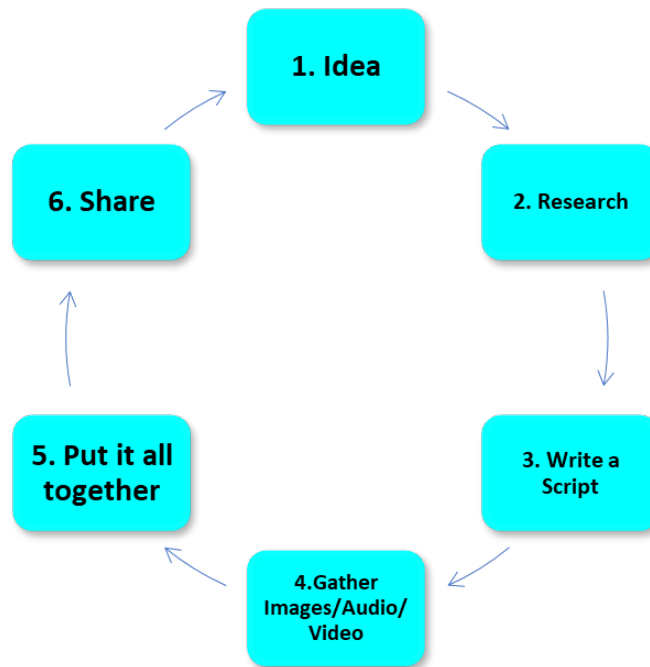
1. Come up with an idea:

2. **Research/explore/learn:** You may need to ask family members about a story that you have heard, or the story may be about yourself. Maybe the story is a historical event that happened, you may need to research the event.

3. **Write a script or find music for your video:** If you only have music, you can add words to the images you will be using. Your music should create a tone for the story.

4. **Gather images, pictures or videos to use for your digital story.** You can also record yourself telling parts of the story too!

5. **Put it all together** in a TikTok or iMovie. Alternatively, you can create a Google Slides presentation with voice recordings. Fill out the checklist on the next page!
6. **Share** your video with me and others if you are comfortable.
